De La Salle College Exam Procedures

STUDY LEAVE

- You have leave to study during the week.
- Exam sessions are up to three hours.
Students are required to remain in the MPC or at workshops for a minimum of two hours unless instructed otherwise.
- Remember study leave is a privilege – students who are not studying will be asked to remain in school.
- Students will be able to study quietly in the library before and after exams.

ENTERING AND EXITING THE EXAM in the MPC

- Students line up outside the MPC [Tuckshop end] in option classes.
If raining, we will leave from area between F and G block. This will be the same for the NZQA exams in November
- Follow the instructions of the Deans and teachers supervising the exams.
- Students place bags at the front of the MPC as they enter.
- No Cell phones. Cell phones are turned off and placed in student's bags.
- Students fill the desks from the front of a row when entering.
- All equipment needs to be in a clear plastic bag – no pencil cases.
- Written work to be done in black or blue pen (not green or red). Pencil is fine but work may not be marked.
- Student names and class teacher need to be written clearly on each part of the exam.
- Wait to be released by the supervisor at the end of the exam.
- Please consider your brothers around you as you leave the MPC.
- Students should leave the school grounds promptly to return home after exams to continue study for their next exam.
- Afternoon exams finish at 3.30pm. Check your travel arrangements for days that you have afternoon exams.

EXAM CONDITIONS

- Exams are quiet places. Students who do not settle will be removed from the exam. School will contact families for you to be collected if needed.
No talking or communicating to any other student at any time during the exam.
- Students are responsible for all equipment including pens, rulers, calculators.
No sharing of equipment
- Only approved calculators are permitted.
- Water ONLY bottles with a sipper top are permitted – no other food or drinks are allowed.
- Students must raise their hand if assistance is required.
- Students need to use the bathroom before coming to the exam.
